NEW SOUTH WALES RECORDED CRIME STATISTICS

**Quarterly Update
September Quarter 2024**

This report presents data on crime reported to, or detected by, police and recorded on the NSW Police Force's Computerised Operational Policing System (COPS). Information is provided on 13 major offence categories, which include the most serious personal violence and property offences, plus a more detailed list of 62 specific offence types.

Figure 1.1: NSW long-term trend in violent offences





Figure 1.2: NSW long-term trend in property offences



Violent offences include: murder, attempted murder, manslaughter, assault - domestic violence related, assault - non-domestic violence related, assault police, robbery without a weapon, robbery with a firearm, robbery with a weapon not a firearm, sexual assault and sexual touching, sexual act and other sexual offences.

Property offences include: break and enter dwelling, break and enter non-dwelling, motor vehicle theft, steal from motor vehicle, steal from retail store, steal from dwelling, steal from person, stock theft and other theft.

Between the 12 months to September 2023 and the 12 months to September 2024





Figure 3.6: Offences with the largest change in the number of young people proceeded against to court by the NSW Police Force

Between the 12 months to September 2023 and the 12 months to September 2024





APPENDIX 2

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Appendix 2.1: Explanatory Notes

What are crime statistics?

BOCSAR's crime statistics consist of criminal incidents reported to, or detected by, police and recorded on the NSW Police Force's Computerised Operational Policing System (COPS). While this system is used for record-keeping for all police operations, not just for criminal matters, BOCSAR only reports on criminal incidents and selected policing activities. BOCSAR's crime statistics therefore do not capture crimes that are not recorded on COPS. The Australian Bureau of Statistics conducts regular crime and victim surveys which attempt to capture a snapshot of both reported and unreported crimes.

How to interpret crime statistics

Recorded crime statistics for some offence categories do not accurately reflect the actual level of crime in the community. This is because the number of incidents recorded may be affected by extraneous factors which are not easily measured. In particular:

- > Public willingness to report crime - Many crimes which occur are not reported to police and will therefore not be recorded - for example, a large number of assaults, sexual assaults and robberies are not reported to police.
- > Shifts in policing policy - Recording of those offences which are detected by, rather than reported to police, are strongly affected by policing practices - examples of these are drug offences, drink driving offences, offensive behaviour and receiving stolen goods. Recorded rates for such offences do not accurately reflect
- > High visitor populations compared to residential populations - Sydney Local Government Area has relatively high recorded crime rates because, compared with other regions, the resident population is small relative to the number of people in the area. In other words, the area has a high user population which is not reflected in the denominator of the rate calculation.
- > Areas with small residential populations - Recorded crime rates in Local Government Areas with small population sizes are not always a good indicator of offending. Crime rates in areas with populations under 3,000 may be unreliable and should be interpreted with caution.

What offences are included?

BOCSAR's standard quarterly publications report on 13 major offence categories, which include serious personal violence and property offences. In addition to these offences, we also release data for 62 specific offence categories.

The offence of coercive control is included from the September Quarter 2024. This offence relates to the use of abusive behaviours directed towards a current or former intimate partner with the intention to coerce or control them. The criminal offence captures repeated patterns of physical or non-physical abuse used to hurt, scare, intimidate, threaten or control someone. The law applies to abusive behaviour from 1 July 2024.

From the September Quarter 2021 report, the offence category previously labelled 'indecent sexual assault, act of indecency and other sexual offences' is labelled 'sexual touching, sexual act and other sexual offences'.

Commencing March 2020, the NSW Government issued public health orders under the NSW Public Health Act 2010 (NSW) to limit the spread of COVID-19. Police can issue a fine or court attendance notice for failure to comply with the orders. Breaches of these orders are counted as "other offences" in this report.

What is being counted?

- > Incidents - When a crime is reported to, or detected by, the NSW Police they record it as a criminal event on COPS. The event date is the date that the crime was reported. Unless otherwise stated, the date BOCSAR attaches to a crime is the event date. One criminal event can contain multiple criminal incidents. BOCSAR's default counting unit for crime data is criminal incidents with the exception of murder and manslaughter. For murder and manslaughter only, the counting units used are victims. Criminal incidents are activities detected by or reported to police which involve the same offender(s) and victim(s); occur at the one location during one uninterrupted period of time; fall into one offence category and one incident type.

> People proceeded against - BOCSAR reports on people identified as 'Persons of Interest' (POIs) by the NSW Police Force who have had a legal proceeding commenced against them by the NSW Police Force. POIs counted in this report have been proceeded against to court or by way of diversion from court, and may not end up with a proven offence. There could be quite some time between an event being recorded by police, an investigation being completed and an alleged offender (i.e. a POI) being charged or otherwise legally proceeded against. Consequently, POIs are counted in the time period they were proceeded against, rather than the time period the event /incident was reported to or recorded by police.

> Legal proceedings against persons presented in Tables 3.1 and 3.2 include persons proceeded against to court and persons diverted from court (by way of criminal infringement notice, cannabis or other drug caution and diversions under the *Young Offenders Act 1997*, including Youth Justice Conference, Caution and Warning). Young people proceeded against by way of a Warning for Transport and regulatory offences have been excluded from Table 3.2 as Warnings are not a diversion for these offences.

> Proceeded against to court (breach of bail) in Tables 3.1 and 3.2 includes persons with breach of bail as the only incident on the criminal event recorded by the NSW Police Force. Breaching bail is not a criminal offence but it can lead to being brought to court by police for the court to reconsider bail.

> Infringement Notices (fines) are not included in this report as they are not a form of court diversion.

> Persons proceeded against to court by offence type (Table 3.3 and Table 3.4) selects one offence type per criminal event. The offence type is selected based on the most serious offence for which the person was proceeded against using the Median Sentence Ranking (MSR) of the offence. For example, a person legally proceeded against to court for a criminal event involving a serious domestic assault charge and a coercive control charge will be counted under the domestic assault offence category as it has the higher MSR ranking than coercive control. For further information see the BOCSAR's Crime and Justice Bulletin No.142 Measuring Offence Seriousness.

What are crime trends and how are they calculated?

In general, BOCSAR relies upon the Kendall Rank Order Correlation statistical test (or Kendall's tau-b) to determine whether a series is trending upwards, downwards or is stable ($p < .05$). In some tables a stable trend is represented by 'ns' (not significant). The statistical test is applied to the monthly data over the specified period. Where a significant trend is found, the average annual percentage change over the time period is reported. If any of the 12-monthly totals in the series have a value of less than 20, a trend test is not conducted. When this occurs, the relevant cell will be left blank or contain 'n.c.' (not calculated).

For murder and manslaughter incidents, the trend test is applied to the monthly number of recorded victims rather than criminal incidents.

With the June Quarter 2024 update, the report has transitioned from reporting five-year to reporting ten-year trends. The COVID-19 pandemic is associated with reductions in crime rates arising from government-imposed policies and restrictions introduced to minimise the impact of the pandemic. BOCSAR's regular crime reporting is suited to detecting sustained changes in crime rather than sharp fluctuations of the kind we saw in March 2020 and June 2021. By reporting ten-year trends, we aim to provide a more accurate view of longer term trends in crime, reducing the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the trend analysis.

How is the ratio to NSW calculated?

The ratio to NSW rate statistics are a comparison of a NSW regional rate per 100,000 population to the NSW rate per 100,000 population. A ratio of one indicates parity with the NSW rate. Ratios indicating double the NSW rate (or more) before rounding are highlighted in red, whilst ratios indicating half the NSW rate (or less) before rounding are highlighted in green. Ratios are not calculated for regions with a population of less than 3,000.

How are 'young people' and 'adults' defined?

The term 'young people' refers to persons aged 10-17 years at the time of the offence; 'adults' refers to persons aged 18 years and older at the time of the offence.

Regional Statistics

Statistics are provided on the number of criminal incidents (victims for murder) recorded for each of the Statistical Areas Level 4 (SA4s) of NSW as defined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS). Recorded criminal incidents which occurred in correctional, detention or remand centres, however, are not counted in the SA in which the incident occurred. Note that LGA boundaries change from time to time. A criminal incident is counted within a particular region when the location of the offence falls within that region.

What is included in 'selected policing activities'?

- > Bail compliance checks - checks conducted by police to assess if bail conditions are being complied with.
- > ADVO compliance checks - checks conducted by police to assess defendants' compliance with Apprehended Domestic Violence Order (ADVO) conditions. Police are required to speak with all interested parties (ie the protected persons and the defendant) for the compliance check event to be completed. The reported count is the total number of ADVO compliance check events conducted, regardless of whether all interested parties were able to be contacted. If a breach of ADVO is detected, Police may charge the defendant with breaching their ADVO.
- > Move on directions - a 'move on direction' is a direction given to a person by a police officer, under section 198 of the Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Act 2002 (NSW), to leave a public place and not return for a specified period.
- > Searches - If the police have reasonable grounds they may, without a warrant, stop and search a person and anything in their possession or under their control, including a vehicle.
- > Taser use - A Taser is a hand-held electrical device used by the NSW Police Force to temporarily incapacitate a person and/or cause pain through the application of electrical current. It can be used in probe or stun mode.
 - Taser draw/cover: Drawing of the Taser from the holster so as to cover a subject.
 - Taser warning arc: The user demonstrates their Taser is armed by showing the visible flow of electricity (arc) to the subject.
 - Taser probes discharged: The Taser trigger is pulled resulting in the cartridge firing and discharging the two probes. This mode renders the subject temporarily incapacitated.
 - Taser drive stun: The Taser is activated and placed directly against an individual's body. Drive stun mode may cause pain but will not cause paralysis.
- > Detain/convey person to mental health facility - The police detain a person at risk of harm to themselves or others and transport them to a mental health facility for assessment under section 22 of the Mental Health Act 2007 (NSW).

What are non-criminal domestic episodes?

Incidents attended by police where a domestic dispute is recorded as having taken place but no criminal incident has been recorded. The vast majority of these episodes are verbal arguments.
